Beaverton, MI– Brown Machine LLC recently announced several new recent shipments and orders of in-line/continuous and cut sheet thermoforming machines/systems to a diverse range of Asian companies. “Our international business continues to be very active throughout the world’s applications, but especially in Asia with both the packaging/disposables markets, as well as automotive and appliance applications,” stated Bill Kent, VP Sales & Business Development for Brown Machine, LLC. Recent Asian sales activity includes:

### **PACKAGING AND DISPOSABLE MARKETS**

- A large CS-Series thermoformer (CS-4500 model, in-line/continuous sheet servo-driven) and T-Series horizontal trim press (T-350-L model) was recently installed into a Korean manufacturer of flavored milk containers (polystyrene). (Brown also supplied tooling for the project.) After high-speed forming and trimming, the nested containers are transported to the dairy where they are subsequently spin welded together and filled/capped. Maximum mold size for the CS-4500 is 40” wide x 42” long (1016mm x 1067mm)
- A wide range of medical lab products will soon be formed on a CS-Series thermoformer (CS-30x36 model, in-line/continuous sheet servo-driven) and T-Series horizontal trim press (T-130-L model) in a new China facility. The line was specified by a US producer to produce PVC medical trays in this new facility. Maximum mold size for the CS-3036 is 30” wide x 36” long (762mm x 914mm)

- Over the past few months, Brown Machine has shipped several rotary cut sheet thermoformers to Thailand for the production of truck bed liners (HMWHDPE), carpeted automotive components, fender liners, and other automotive interior components (HDPE) . Installed machine lines include the R-223-E and R-224-E Rotary models. Molds sizes to 2.1 meters x 3.3 meters will be utilized.
- A large rotary cut sheet system (R-244-ETS) will soon be shipped to Japan for the production of twin sheet material handling pallets. Molds sizes to 1.8 meters x 3 meters will be utilized.
